**STEWARDSHIP REFLECTION
WEEK 3 OF 6**

Read: 2 Corinthians 8:1-7

In the Old Testament, believers are instructed to give a tenth of their income to the support of the ministry and the needs of the poor. While this is often read as a "requirement and law" it is really to be seen as a way to respond to what God has given and to undergird the work that God seeks to do among his people and beyond. In the New Testament, we are taught that we should give as we "are able and even beyond [our] ability." (2 Corinthians 8:3) In the New Testament, 10% is not seen as a law to meet nor a "bar" to measure our giving by, but as the minimum guideline for our giving.

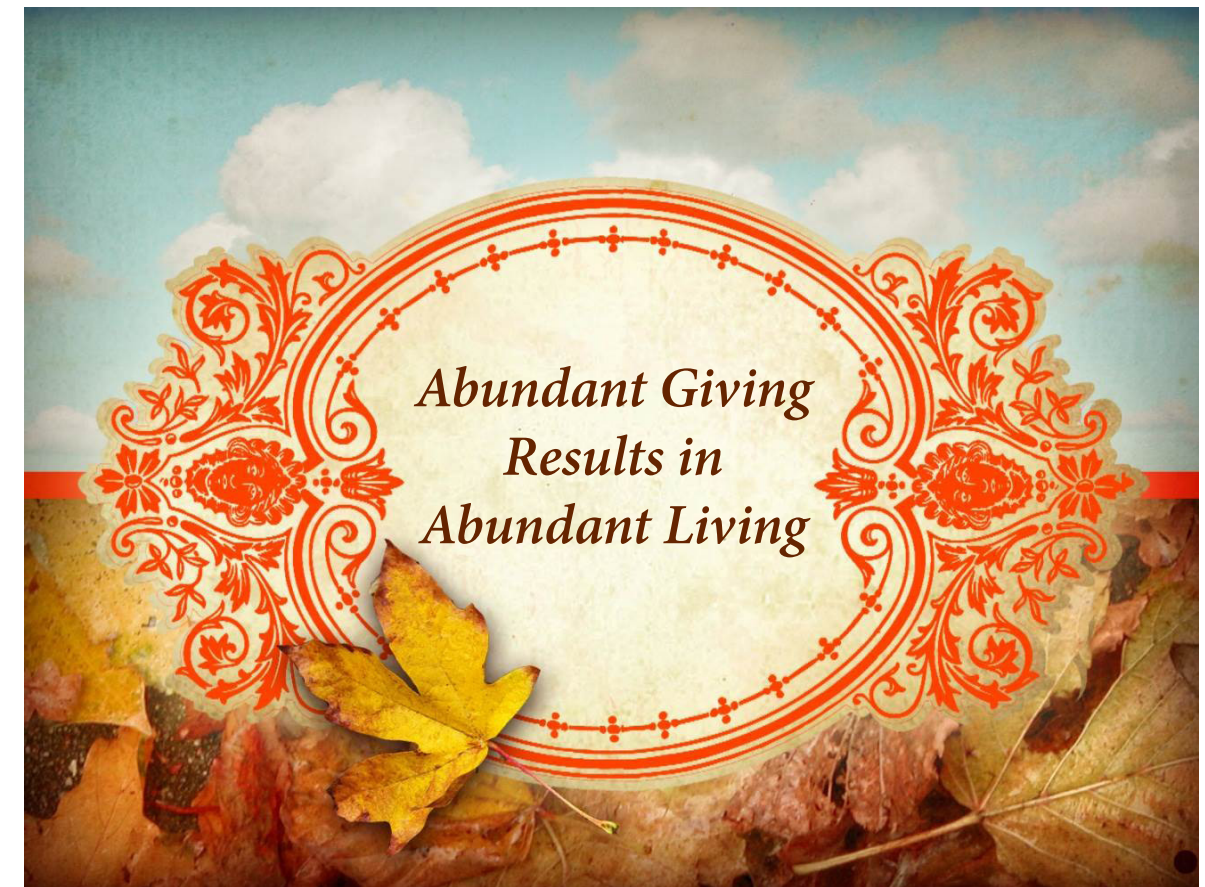
Giving 10% allows us to give proportionally to what we have received. God helps us know how to give, where giving begins and the measure for our response to God's grace.

Reflect on this:

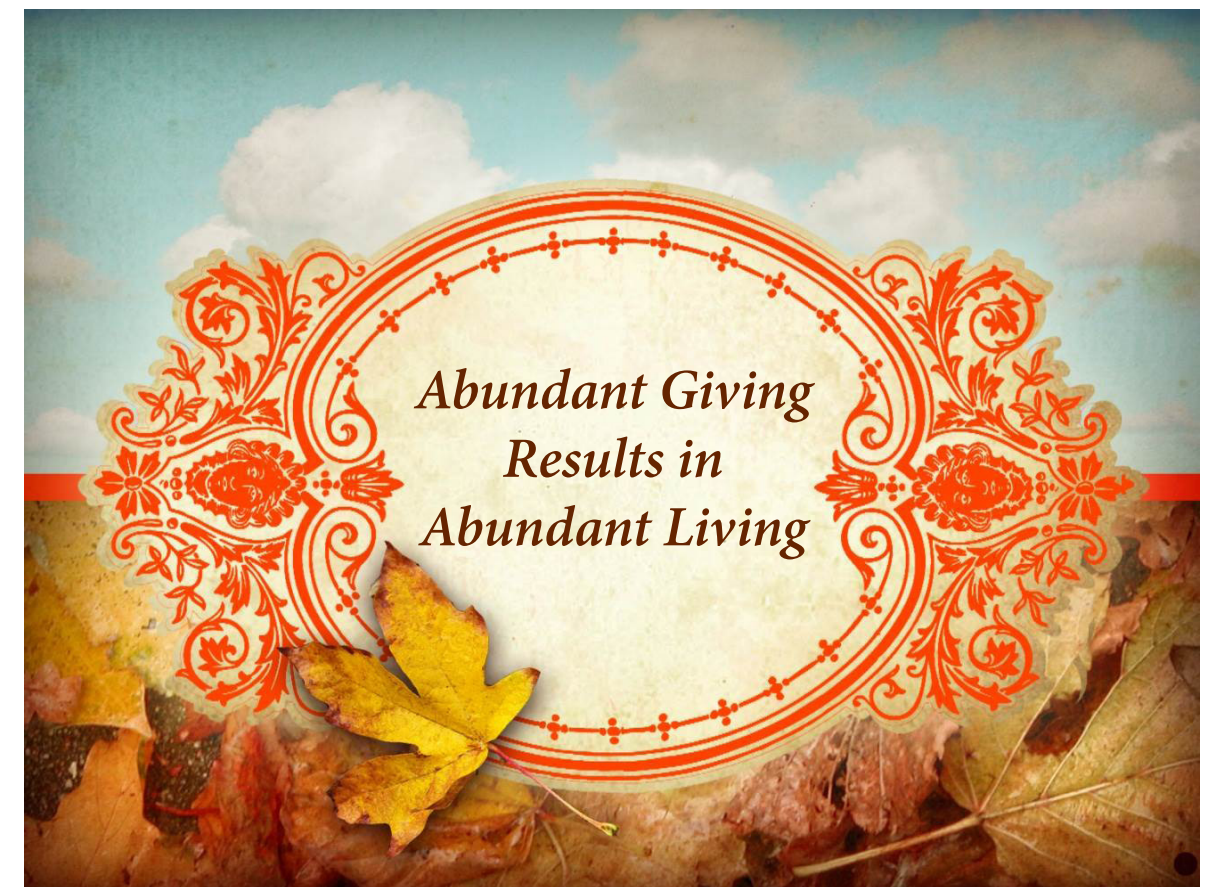
Giving 10% allows us to give proportionally to what we have received. God helps us know how to give, where giving begins and the measure for our response to God's grace.
