40 Days of Adventurous Faith

We're quick to pray for the physical brokenness of those we love, but how attentive are we to spiritual brokenness? Let's take forty days to pray for those who are separated from God that they will draw near through Jesus, and also pray that we might be part of that restoration somehow.

The Big Picture:

- 3 - Invite two other people to join you over the forty days of Lent
- 6 - The three of you meet once each week for the six weeks of Lent (begins March 1)
- 6 - Bring the names of two people each to pray for, totaling six for your group

The church will provide a brief guide for each of your times together. Consider meeting before work, over lunch, after a church gathering or even via an online video service (Skype, GoogleHangout, etc.).
